**£10** a month for a year could buy 40 emergency rest centre packs for people who have been evacuated from their homes following a house fire, flood or extreme weather in the UK.

**£20** a month for a year could provide 68 blankets to keep vulnerable people in Sierra Leone warm in times of crisis.
